He has logged over 800 hours in powered aircraft and 3000 in sailplanes. He currently flies gliders that he owns and glider tow planes (C-182, Pawnee, and CallAir A9-B).

Wally graduated from Texas Tech University with honors and was inducted into the Texas Tech Engineering Technology Academy. He taught various science and technology classes in high school for 21 years and currently works as an electrical engineer in the aerospace/defense industry.

Wally has twice completed a 1000-km (620-mile) sailplane flight, attained a 30,000-foot altitude in one, and holds or has held several sailplane records in He has a Lewin Barringer award for the longest sailplane flight of the year.

He enjoys flying of all types and studies soaring weather theory; serves as ground school instructor at the Hamilton Soaring club in Hamilton, TX; enjoys computer games, flight simulators, and building desktop gaming computers; and flies radio controlled model aircraft, some of which have over 2,000 flights.
